Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, maple, alder, madrona, chinquapin and dogwood; undergrowth, vinemaple, hazel, willow, arrowwood, bracken, salmonberry, thimbleberry, manzanita and slickleaf.

N.  $5^{\circ}24'$  E., bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Desc. 102 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 4.40 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 334 ft. over SE. slope.
- 22.80 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 47 ft. over NE. slope.
- 25.00 A ravine, course E.; asc. 331 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.
- 32.60 A spring, flows SE.
- 38.80 A spur, slopes S.  $60^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 3 ft. over NE. slope.
- 39.98 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- 54.00 A spur, slopes S.  $80^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 208 ft. over NE. slope.
- 65.00 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 38 ft. over SE. slope.
- 70.80 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 101 ft. over NE. slope.
- 73.90 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 64 ft. over SE. slope.
