9.10	A spur, slopes S. 15° E.; desc. 82 ft. over SW. slope.
13.00	A ravine, course S.; asc. 17 ft. over SE. slope.
13.60	Foot of spur, slopes S.; desc. 7 ft. over SW. slope.
14.10	A branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 10° E.; asc. 370 ft. over SE. slope.
32.50	A spur, slopes S.; desc. 82 ft. over SW. slope, through old burn.
33.10	Harness Mountain Trail, bears N. 5° W. and S.
38.72	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 20, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. 43.20	Foot of spur, slopes S.; desc. 19 ft. over SW. slope.
44.00	A ravine, course SE.; asc. 108 ft. over NE. slope.
49.00	A spur, slopes S. 30° E.; desc. 453 ft. over SW. slope.
56.15	An abandoned dirt logging road, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
57.15	Timothy Creek, 7 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 268 ft. over broken NE. slope.
67.50	A shallow ravine, course N. 80° E.
77.44	The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20. Land, mountainous. Soil, heavy sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, dogwood and yew. Undergrowth, vinemaple, slickleaf, manzanita, thimbleberry, bracken, willow, arrowwood, hazel, salal, and huckleberry.

11.00	A spur, slopes SE.; descend 127 ft. over SW. slope, gradually leaving old burn and entering green timber along S. edge of logged area.

22.90	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 72 ft. over broken SW. slope.
33.80	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.
