38.43 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 18 and 19, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 64 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 BT.

Asc. 192 ft. over broken E. slope.

48.90 A ridge, (divide bet. Timothy Creek and Oldham Creek) bears N. and S.; desc. 434 ft. over broken W. slope.

61.80 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 60° W.; asc. 18 ft. over NE. slope.

71.85 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 106 ft. over NW. slope.

74.15 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 61 ft. over NE. slope.

75.60 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 7 ft. along broken N. slope.

76.21 The cor. of secs. 18 and 19, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, heavy sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, chinquapin, maple, alder, madrona, yew and dogwood.; undergrowth, vinemaple, arrowwood, willow, slick-leaf, manzanita, bracken, thimbleberry, hazel and huckleberry.

From the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20

N. 1°32' E., bet. secs. 17 and 18.

Desc. 166 ft. over broken NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, in old burn.

15.50 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 28 ft. over SE. slope.

18.70 Leave old burn and enter green timber, edge bears E. and W.

20.30 Top of ascent on E. slope; desc. 83 ft. over NE. slope.

26.55 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 12 ft. over SE. slope.

26.95 Foot of spur, slopes E.; desc. 17 ft. over NE. slope.

27.60 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course E.; at confluence with Timothy Creek, 4 lks. wide, course SE. from N. 1°30' E.; asc. 15 ft. along Timothy Creek in narrow bottom.

30.15 A branch, 1 lk. wide, from NE. at confluence with Timothy Creek.

31.25 Leave Timothy Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S. 1°30' W. from NW; asc. 132 ft. along top of spur, slopes S.

38.835 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
