CHAINS 22.30	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 17 ft. over SW. slope.
23.70	A branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.; asc. 42 ft. along broken S. slope.
39.065	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 17, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
