

Dependent Resurvey of the S. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- Asc. 26 ft. over rolling broken S. slope.
- 15.25 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 97 ft. over broken SE. slope.
- 16.60 A spring branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.
- 22.60 A branch, 10 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 322 ft. over broken W. slope.
- 29.12 A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 45 ft. over SE. slope.
- 36.70 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 75 ft. over SW. slope.
- 40.50 The original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, the locus of which has been perpetuated by a county surveyor's cedar stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set, mkd. C S T 25 S R 3 W S 33 on NE., T 26 S S 4 on SE., S 5 on SW., and S 32 on NW. face;

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with the county surveyor's marked stake deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, with brass cap mkd.

from which

- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.25°E., 24 lks. dist., mkd. on bark T 25 S R 3 W S 33 B T. (Old B.T.)
- A fir, 34 ins. diam., dead and down, bears S.63°W., 8 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on old bark blaze. (Old B.T.)
- A fir 40 ins. diam., bears S.55°E., dead and down, 5 lks. dist., mkd. on bark T 26 S R 3 W S 4 B T. (Old B.T.)
- A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N.2°W., 30 lks. dist., an old bearing tree which has fallen and only part of the old bark blaze is visible.
- A yew, 7 ins. diam., bears N.20°W., 27 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 32 C S B T. (County surveyor's B.T.)
- A yew, 8 ins. diam., bears N.37½°E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 33 B T. (New B.T.)
- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.76°E., 73 lks. dist., mkd. T 26 S R 3 W S 4 B T. (New B.T.)
- A yew, 8 ins. diam., bears S.62°W., 15 lks. dist., mkd. T 26 S R 3 W S 5 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, sandy loam and clay; 1st and 2d rate.  
 Timber, fir, cedar, oak, yew, madrona, maple, dogwood, and hemlock.  
 Undergrowth, vinemapple, lilac, poison oak, arrowwood, hazel, willow, slickleaf, and bracken.
