

Dependent Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

Asc. 23 ft. over SE. slope.

3.70 A spur, slopes S.70°E.; desc. 3 ft. over NE. slope.

9.00 The W. edge of a swamp about 2 chs. in diameter; asc. 214 ft. over S. slope, changing to SE. slope.

20.60 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 71 ft. over NE. slope.

26.30 A ravine, course E.; asc. 95 ft. over SE. slope.

33.67 The original closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, the badly decayed remains of a fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. square, on which no scribe marks remain.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with decayed fir stake deposited at the base, for closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, with brass cap mkd.

A red cedar, 11 ins. diam., bears N.66½°E., 28 lks. dist., with blaze healed. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 2 W S 18 C C B T.

A fir, 64 ins. diam., bears S.70°E., 54 lks. dist., with old blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

Asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope.

41.00 Point for original sec. cor. which now refers to secs. 13 and 24 only, determined by reference to the record measurements from the old SE., SW., and NW. bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 13 and 24, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S.57½°E., 27 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 2 W S 19 B T. I obliterate the marks on this old bearing tree.

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears S.17½°W., 24 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on old bark blaze. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 3 W S 24 B T.

A fir stub, 20 ins. diam., bears N.42½°W., 129 lks. dist., on which the marks B T and other partial scribe marks are visible. (Old B.T.)

A hemlock, 9 ins. diam., bears N.38½°W., 19 lks.
