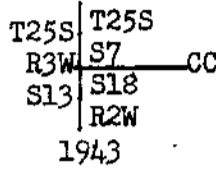


Dependent Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.



from which

An incense cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears N.11 3/4°E., 79 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 2 W S 7 C C B T.

An incense cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.63°E., 113 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 2 W S 18 C C B T.

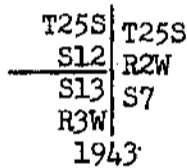
Asc. 208 ft. over SW. slope.

78.34

Point for original sec. cor. which now refers to secs. 12 and 13 only, determined by reference to the record bearings and distances from the original NE. and NW. bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 12 and 13, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.15°E., 16 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 2 W S 7 B T. I obliterate the marks on this old bearing tree.

A hemlock, 22 ins. diam., bears N.15°W., 17 lks. dist., on which I uncovered the scribe marks 3 S 12 beneath 60 years overgrowth. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.56 1/2°W., 47 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 13 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.53 1/2°W., 37 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 12 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, cedar, madrona, maple, oak, alder, chinquapin, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, lilac, arrowwood, poison oak, manzanita, slickleaf, willow, salal, hazel, and bracken.

N. 0° 51' E., along E. bdy. of sec. 12.

Asc. 130 ft. over SW. slope, changing to SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

A spur, slopes S.60°E.; desc. 78 ft. over NE. slope.

21.80

Foot of descent on E. slope; asc. 28 ft. over SE. slope.
