

Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

An incense cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S.49 3/4°W., 24 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 B T. (New B.T.)

Thence

N. 0° 22' W., with new measurement.

Desc. 144 ft. over NW. slope, changing to NE. slope.

3.95 Same branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.5°E., desc. 205 ft. over NE. slope.

8.90 Gassy Creek, 12 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 410 ft. over SW. slope.

22.75 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 84 ft. over NW. slope.

26.55 A ravine, course W.; asc. 65 ft. over SW. slope.

30.10 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 171 ft. over NW. slope.

35.70 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.60°W.; asc. 93 ft. over broken S. slope.

38.76 The original cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, the badly decayed remains of a wooden stake, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, firmly set, on which partial scribe marks remain.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with marked stake deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, with brass cap mkd.

A dead madrona, 12 ins. diam., bears N.17 1/4°E., 14 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on decayed blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.70 3/4°E., 21 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

An incense cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears S.45 3/4°W., 18 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.26°W., 17 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

An incense cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.60 3/4°E., 42 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 WS 18 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy and rocky loam; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, alder, maple, madrona, chinquapin, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, lilac, willow, hazel, arrowwood, bracken, almohberry, and poison oak.

N. 0° 51' E., bet. secs. 13 and 18.

Asc. 152 ft. over broken S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

6.40 A spur, slopes S.70°W.; desc. 42 ft. over NW. slope.
