

Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

dist., with incomplete scribe marks visible on partially uncovered old blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir stump, 38 ins. diam., bears S.83°E., 88 lks. dist., with scribe marks B T on decayed old blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir stump, 12 ins. diam., bears S.77°W., 25 lks. dist., with only ax marks remaining on decayed face of old blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.25°E., 48 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 7 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.40°E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 18 B T. (New B.T.)

A maple, 14 ins. diam., bears S.7½°W., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 4 W S 13 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.18 ¾°W., 32 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 4 W S 12 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy and rocky loam; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, chinquapin, dogwood, and oak.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, arrowwood, lilac, salal, hazel, willow, slickleaf, manzanita, and salmonberry.

N. 0° 31' E., bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Asc. 92 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.75 A wire fence, bears N.5°E., and S.5°W.; thence along E. edge of old clearing.

7.35 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 16 ft. over NW. slope.

9.35 A ravine, course W.; asc. 78 ft. over SW. slope.

16.80 A spur, slopes NW.; NE. cor. of old clearing, bears S. and W.; desc. 334 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

27.00 Enter bottom land, bears NW. and SE.

28.80 A dim trail, bears NW. and SE.

29.00 Field Creek, 10 lks. wide, course NW.

35.00 Leave bottom land and heavy timber and dense undergrowth and enter prairie with scattering oak timber, bears NW. and SE.; asc. 28 ft. over rolling SW. slope.

40.62 Point for original ¼ sec. cor., determined at record measurements from both old bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
