

Dependent Resurvey of the S. Bdy. of T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

Asc. 46 ft. over SW. slope.

6.60 A flat topped spur, slopes S.30°E.; desc. 160 ft. over E. slope.

15.40 A branch, 1 lk.-wide, course SE.; asc. 54 ft. over SW. slope.

20.60 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 42 ft. over SE. slope.

23.50 A branch, 6 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 414 ft. over broken NW. slope.

38.00 A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course NW.

40.36 Point for original cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, determined by reference to the record distance from each of the old bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.53°E., 41 lks. dist., mkd. on bark T 24 S R 3 W S 36 B T. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 24 S R 3 W S 36 B T.

A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears S.77°E., 15 lks. dist., with no scribe marks remaining on badly weathered face of old bark blaze. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 3 W S 1 B T.

A fir, 58 ins. diam., bears S.64°W., 58 lks. dist., with no scribe marks remaining on badly weathered face of old bark blaze. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 3 W S 2 B T.

A fir stump, 40 ins. diam., bears N.70°W., 17 lks. dist., with no scribe marks remaining on badly weathered face of old bark blaze. (Old B.T.)

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears N.39½°E., 58 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 36 B T. (New B.T.)

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N.10°W., 4 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 35 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, yew, madrona, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salmonberry, salal, arrowwood, manzanita, slickleaf, willow, lilac, syringa, bracken, hazel, poison oak, and Oregon grape.

Asc. 282 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
