CHAINS

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, alder, pine, maple, chinquapin, madrona, and dogwood.
Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salal, manzanita, slickleaf, arrowwood, salmonberry, bracken, willow, hazel, huckleberry, and syringa.

From the cor. of secs. 1 and 12 only, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 89° 43' W., bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Asc. 33 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 2.30 A trail and telephone line, bears N, and S.
- 2.40 A ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 1,338 ft. over broken W. slope.
- 26.35 Top of a bluff, 80 ft. high, bears N. and S.
- 41.00 A branch, 8 lks. wide, course S.75°W., asc. 24 ft. over SE. slope.
- 45.29 Proportional measurement.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

- 64.10 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 43 ft. over SE. slope.
- 70.30 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 8 ft. over SW. slope.
- 71.55 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.30°E.; asc. 55 ft. over NE. slope.
- 76.60 A spur, slopes S.15°E.; desc. 17 ft. over rolling broken S. slope.
- 84.30 A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 46 ft. over SW. slope.
- 90.58 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12.
