CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

S. 8° 41' W., bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Asc. 13 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.50 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 323 ft. over SW. slope.

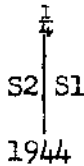
11.70 A branch, 10 lks. wide, course N.80°W.; asc. 654 ft. over N. slope, changing to broken NW. slope.

16.40 A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.30°W.

40.40 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.

42.15 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

44.40 Head of ravine, course N.70°W.; asc. 141 ft. over NW. slope.

52.50 A spur, slopes N.80°W.; desc. 152 ft. over SW. slope.

59.40 Head of ravine, course N.80°W.; asc. 27 ft. over NW. slope.

60.60 A spur, slopes N.80°W.; desc. 129 ft. over SW. slope.

71.10 A ravine, course W.; asc. 79 ft. over NW. slope.

74.20 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 87 ft. over SW. slope.

80.10 Head of ravine, course N.70°W.; asc. 98 ft. over NW. slope.

84.40 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.
