

Dependent Resurvey of the Sub. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 187 ft. over SE. slope.

87.60

A spur, slopes S.70°E; desc. 6 ft. over NE. slope.

94.70

A branch, 2 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 32 ft. over SE. slope.

The original cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, the badly decayed remains of a yew post, 3½ ft. long, 4 ins. square, loosely set, on which only ax marks were found.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with remains of yew post deposited at the base for cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.29 3/4°E., 40 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on old bark blaze. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 3 W S 22 B T.

A hemlock, 28 ins. diam., bears S.55°E., 28 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on old blaze which is almost healed. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 3 W S 27 B T.

A fir, 44 ins. diam., dead and down, bears S.45°W., 32 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on old bark blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N.24°W., 13 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on old bark blaze. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 25 S R 3 W S 21 B T.

A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S.49°W., 35 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 28 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, yew, chinquapin, maple, alder, madrona, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, willow, bracken, hazel, arrowwood, manzanita, and slickleaf.

From the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27

S. 89° 03' W., bet. secs. 22 and 27.

Asc. 134 ft. over broken S. slope along top of spur, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
