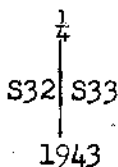


Dependent Resurvey of the Sub. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

from which

A yew, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $82\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 42 lks.
 dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 B T.

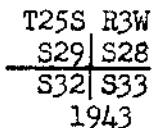
A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears S. $61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 48 lks.
 dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T.

Over W. slope.

- 40.00 A spur, slopes S. 75° W.; desc. 88 ft. over NW. slope.
- 49.30 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 466 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 52.40 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course SW.
- 59.60 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course SW.
- 69.00 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.
- 76.46 Point for original cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33, determined by reference to the record measurements from all of the original bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33, with brass cap mkd.

An incense cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears N. $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 10 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 28 B T. (Old B.T.)

An incense cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 72° E., 7 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 33 B T. (Old B.T.)

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 37 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 32 B T. (Old B.T.)

An incense cedar, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 38° W., 15 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 29 B T. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. $58\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 38 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 33 B T. (New B.T.)

A yew, 7 ins. diam., bears S. $25\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 19 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 32 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, yew, madrona, chinquapin, dogwood, and pine.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, salmonberry, arrowwood, bracken, willow, hazel, lilac, and syringa.

From the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34

N. $89^{\circ} 43'$ W., bet. secs. 28 and 33.
