	Asc. 129 ft. over broken SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
17.30	A spur, ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 29 ft. over SW. slope.
20.30	Foot of descent on S. slope; asc. 61 ft. over SE. slope.
31.00	A trail and telephone line, bears N. and S.
31.80	A spur, slopes S.; desc. 180 ft. over SW. slope.
39.40	Point for original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., determined by reference to the record measurements from both original bearing trees.
