

Dependent Resurvey of the Sub. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 3.30 A graded and graveled logging road and telephone line, bears N. and S. 10° E.
 - 8.20 A branch, 6 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 27 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 10.20 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 183 ft. over W. slope.
 - 19.00 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 81 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 21.80 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 66 ft. over NW. slope.
 - 24.80 A ravine, course N.; asc. 117 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 32.20 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
 - 36.50 A ravine, course N.; asc. 97 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 42.40 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 84 ft. over NW. slope, changing to SW. slope.
 - 44.88 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9.

Land, mountainous and rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 1st, 2d, and 3d rate.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, yew, madrona, chinquapin, dogwood, pine, and oak.
Undergrowth, vinemaple, salmonberry, willow, arrowwood, salal, slickleaf, manzanita, bracken, hazel, and lilac.

- Desc. 13 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 3.60 A spur, slopes SE.; desc. 182 ft. over S. slope.
 - 11.50 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 6 ft. over NE. slope.
 - 22.00 A spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. 158 ft. over SW. slope.
 - 27.03 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., a fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 T 25 S R 3 W on E., and S 5 C S on W. face.

- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with the county surveyor's marked stake deposited at the base, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
