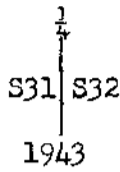


Dependent Resurvey of the Sub. of T. 25 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S.11°E., 63 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 32 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.4°W., 109 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T.

Asc. 306 ft. over broken SW. slope.

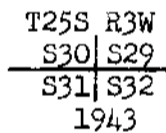
75.00 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 42 ft. over NW. slope.

79.00 Head of ravine, course SW.; asc. 358 ft. over S. slope. changing to SW. slope.

92.30 The original cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32, the badly disintegrated remains of a yew post on which no marks remain.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with remains of yew post deposited at the base for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N.85 $\frac{1}{4}$ °E., 96 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on bark blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 64 ins. diam., bears S.44°E., 60 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on bark blaze. (Old B.T.)

An incense cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears S.13 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 147 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on bark blaze. (Old B.T.)

An incense cedar, 32 ins. diam., bears N.61 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 94 lks. dist., on which I uncovered partial scribe marks beneath 60 years overgrowth. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.77  $\frac{3}{4}$ °E., 116 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 29 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.61 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 19 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 32 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.46°W., 74 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 W S 31 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 1st, 2d, and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, oak, madrona, maple, alder, chinquapin, yew, pine, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, lilac, arrowwood, willow, poison oak, wild rose, salal, salmonberry, thimbleberry, hazel, manzanita, slickleaf, and bracken.
