Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky clay; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, yew, madrona, pine, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, salmonberry, manzanita, slickleaf, bracken, arrowwood, hazel, and willow.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 79° 12' E., bet. secs. 19 and 30.

Desc. 167 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

A ravine, course SE.; asc. 85 ft. over SW. slope.

A trail, bears NW. and SE.

A ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 14 ft. over broken N. slope.
