42.10 Trail, bears N. and S.

53.45 Foot of conglomerate bluffs; leave timber.

55.55 Top of bluffs, 175 ft. high.

56.45 Deep rift in rock, course N.; ascend.

62.67 Top of rock dome; descend.

67.65 Deep ravine, course S. 15° W.; ascend solid wall of rock.

74.25 Rock spur, slopes S.; descend.

78.05 Ravine, course S.; ascend.

78.46 A point South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, solid rock and rocky red clay, 3rd and 4th rate.
Timber, yellow pine, fir, white oak, black oak and live oak.
Undergrowth, chaparral, willow and myrtle.

S. 88°18' W., surveying S. bdy. of sec. 32.

Along SE. slope, over conglomerate bluffs.

3.88 Point for cor. of secs. 4 and 5, T. 31 S., R. 7 W., falls on conglomerate bluffs where it is impracticable to establish cor. See W.C. on line bet. secs. 4 and 5 subdivision of T. 31 S., R. 7 W.

6.80 Deep rift in bluffs, course S.

8.05 Rock spur, slopes S.

11.30 Rift in bluffs, course S.

29.75 Top of bluffs; enter heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
