CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 85°30' E., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 7 W S 29 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 77°30' E., 44 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 7 W S 32 BT.

A yellow pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 59°30' W., 83 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 7 W S 31 BT.

A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 83° W., 181 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 7 W S 30 BT.

The true course and length of this line from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. is N. 87°14' E., 39.38 chs.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, shale rocks and rocky loam, 3rd and 4th rate.  
Timber, fir, live oak and madrona.  
Undergrowth, live oak, madrona and tan oak.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. North, retracing line bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Descend NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 1.75 Foot of slope.
- 1.90 Trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 5.10 Cow Creek, 410 lks. wide, course NE.; ascend.
- 9.85 Fence, bears N. 55° E. and S. 55° W.
- 10.10 Center of S. P. Ry. track on curve, bears N. 55° E. and S. 55° W.
- 11.15 Fence, bears N. 55° E. and S. 55° W.; ascend steep S. slope.
- 18.50 Top of spur, slopes SE.; desc. steep NE. slope.
- 26.75 Polan Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.; ascend steep SW. slope.
- 39.43 Fall 41 lks. W. of the point for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., located by reference to the bearing trees. At the exact corner point
