

Retracement Portion Subdivisions, T. 31 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS  
44.90 Trail, bears E. and W.; descend steep NE. slope.  
49.00 Ravine, course E.; ascend.  
50.35 Low spur, slopes E.; descend.  
56.30 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course E.; ascend steep S. slope.  
65.25 Ravine, course S. 70° W.  
67.75 Ascend bluffs, sloping SW.  
70.00 After diligent search I fail to find any evidence of the old witness cor.  
77.75 Foot of conglomerate bluffs.  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. to the cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.

A live oak, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 87°30' W., 51 lks. dist., mkd. W C T 31 S R 7 W S 5 BT.

A white oak, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 55°15' E., 126 lks. dist., mkd. W C T 31 S R 7 W S 4 BT.

Ascend over bluffs.

78.08 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 3.88 chs. S. 88°18' W. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, point for cor. of secs. 4 and 5, impracticable to establish corner.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, to 68.00 chs. gravelly black loam, 2nd rate; remainder, solid rock, 4th rate.

Timber, fir, white oak, black oak, yellow pine and live oak.

Undergrowth, live oak, poison oak, chaparral and fir.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8

North, retracing line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Ascend S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.35 Low spur, slopes SE.; descend NE. slope.

7.10 Wire fence, bears NW. and SE.; enter clearing.

15.15 Wire fence, bears NW. and SE.

16.25 Table Creek, 15 lks. wide, course SE.

18.40 Logsdon's house bears N. 38° W., 5.00 chs. dist. Barn bears S. 60° W., 1.30 chs. dist.

18.60 Picket fence, bears E. and W.

23.50 Rail fence, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.

Leave clearing; ascend SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

30.70 Top of spur, slopes SW.; descend NW. slope.
