T 22 S R 8 W S 18 B T, under 4 inches of overgrowth.A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 56° W., 43 lks. dist., mkd. with a scar of an old blaze but no scribe marks.

New bearing trees:

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 83° E., 33 lks. dist., mkd. T 22 S R 8 W S 8 B T.A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S. 19° E., 76 lks. dist., mkd. T 22 S R 8 W S 17 B T.A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. $8^{\circ} 15'$ W., 23 lks. dist., mkd. T 22 S R 8 W S 18 B T.A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. $81^{\circ} 45'$ W., 33 lks. dist., mkd. T 22 S R 8 W S 7 B T.
