	<p>Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salmonberry, salal and bracken.</p>
	<p>S. 87°06' W., along S. bdy. of sec. 34.</p> <p>Ascend 110 ft. over E. slope, through fern opening.</p>
3.00	Enter heavy timber and dense undergrowth, edge bears N. and S.
5.07	<p>The cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 21 S., R. 10 W., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record. 11.75	A branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 210 ft. over E. slope.
15.30	A spur, slopes N.; desc. 315 ft. over W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
23.50	A branch, 1 lk. wide, in bare rock channel, 10 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 390 ft. over bluffy E. slope, changing to NE. slope.
31.20	A sharply defined spur, slopes N. 5° E.; desc. 40 ft. over W. slope.
32.20	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 29 ft. over E. slope.
34.14	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., the top rusted off 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>$\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 1919</p> </div> <p>from which the remaining 1919 bearing tree</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 5° W., 66 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Record bearing N. 6° W.)</p> <p>In place of the old post, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked</p>
