

Dependent Resurvey of E. Bdy. of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS	
8.15	A gravelled road, bears N. 68° W. and S. 75° E.
8.75	A power line, bears N. 73°22' W. and S. 73°22' E.
11.50	Edge of bottom, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.; asc. 95 ft. over S. slope.
15.35	A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.
17.00	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 225 ft. over S. slope, through scattering timber and undergrowth; edge bears NE. and SW.
23.80	A spur, slopes SE.; asc. 120 ft. along E. slope, changing to SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth; edge bears NW. and SE.
33.30	The head of a ravine, course SE.; asc. 71 ft. over S. slope.
35.45	A ridge, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.; desc. 168 ft. over steep N. slope.
38.77	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with an unmarked sandstone, 18 x 18 x 16 ins., firmly set 12 ins. in the ground, from which the remaining original bearing tree,  A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S. 86 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 60 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed.  At the corner point  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked  <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>S 36   S 31 1951</p> </div> from which a new bearing tree  A cedar, 48 ins. diam., bears S. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 73 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 BT.  Deposit the unmarked sandstone at the base of the iron post.  N. 1°45' W., beginning new measurement.  Descend 135 ft. over steep N. slope.
3.00	A ravine, course N. 35° W.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
6.00	A spur, slopes N. 25° W.; desc. 150 ft. over steep NW. slope.
8.20	The dry bed of a stream, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° W.; asc. 190 ft. over S. slope.
11.60	A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 205 ft. over N. slope.
17.25	A branch, 3 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 70 ft. over S. slope.
18.40	A spur, slopes W.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
19.60	A wet ravine, course S. 50° W.; asc. 370 ft. over SW. slope.
26.75	A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 47 ft. over NW. slope.
28.40	A ravine, course SW.; asc. 150 ft. over S. slope.
32.75	A spur, slopes W.; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.
