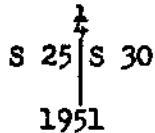

Foot of descent on W. slope; asc. 11 ft. along W. slope.

39.23

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 36° E., 32 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 30 BT.A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 31°15' W., 14 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 BT.

Along W. slope.

A ridge, the divide bet. Smith River and Bear Creek, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 325 ft. over NE. slope.

48.00

A ravine, course NE.; asc. 9 ft. over E. slope.

50.35

Top of ascent on E. slope; desc. 89 ft. over NE. slope.

52.30

The dry bed of a stream, 3 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 76 ft. over SE. slope.

53.95

A spur, slopes E.; desc. 105 ft. over NE. slope.

57.10

A branch, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 55 ft. over SE. slope.

58.85

A spur, slopes SE.; thence along E. slope.

59.80

The head of a ravine, course SE.; asc. 274 ft. over precipitous S. slope.

66.70

A junction of spurs, from S. 70° W., slope N. 80° E. and NE.; desc. 350 ft. over N. slope.

74.50

A ravine, course NE.; asc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.

75.20

A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 65 ft. over NE. slope.

76.60

The dry bed of a stream, 5 lks. wide, course S. 85° E.; asc. 90 ft. over SE. slope.

78.46

The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, monumented with a sandstone 16 x 10 x 6 ins., firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, mkd. with 2 notches on S. edge, from which the remaining original bearing trees,

A fir, 66 ins. diam., bears N. 3° E., 45 lks. dist., with the scribe marks T 20 S R 10 W S 24 BT plainly visible on bark blaze. (Record description, N. 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 53 lks. dist.)

A maple, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 85° E., 94 lks. dist., with no marks remaining on decayed blaze. (Record bearing, N. 87° E.)

A cedar, 50 ins. diam., bears S. 0°45' E., 211 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Record bearing and distance, S. 3° E., 225 lks.)
