A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears N. 25° W., 13 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 BT. (A Mensch bearing tree.)

An alder, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 81°45' W., 80 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 BT. (A new bearing tree.)

N. 9°59' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 105 ft. over S. slope.

1.83 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7, T. 20 S., R. 9 W., monumented with an
iron post, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked
and witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 10°20' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 55 ft. over S. slope.

1.20 Top of a hill in ridge, the divide bet. Johnson Creek and Cedar
Creek, bears NE. and SW.; spurs slope NW. and SE.; desc. 340 ft.
over NW. slope.

7.50 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course W.; asc. 65 ft. over SW. slope.

10.20 A spur, slopes S. 80° W.; desc. 150 ft. over NE. slope.

13.00 A ravine, course N. 60° W.; asc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.

13.70 Point of a spur, slopes W.; desc. 25 ft. over NW. slope.

14.40 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 50° W.; asc. 140 ft. over S. slope.

17.20 A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 115 ft. over NW. slope.

19.70 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 70° W.; asc. 240 ft. over broken
SW. slope.

25.60 A spur, slopes S. 80° W.; desc. 85 ft. over NW. slope.

28.65 The cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins.
diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as
described in the official record.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder and maple.

Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, hazel and salmon-
berry.

N. 9°24' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

Descend 75 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-
growth.

2.00 A ravine, course SW.; asc. 210 ft. over S. slope.

6.20 A spur ridge, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.; desc. 265 ft. over
NW. slope.

11.60 A ravine, course S. 75° W.; asc. 12 ft. over SW. slope.
