

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the N. Bdy. of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS  
32.50

A spur, slopes NW.; asc. 109 ft. along broken N. slope.

37.18

Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

$$\frac{1}{4} \begin{array}{l} S 35 \\ S 2 \\ 1952 \end{array}$$

from which

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 71° E., 10 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 35 BT.

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., 22 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 2 BT.

Ascend 180 ft. over NW. slope.

A spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 460 ft. over broken NE. slope.

A branch, 6 lks. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 87 ft. over NW. slope.

64.50

A spur, slopes N.; Desc. 166 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope.

Bob Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.

Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

from which

A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 111 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 10 W S 36 BT.

An alder, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 47°45' E., 25 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 1 BT.

An alder, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 63 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 2 BT.

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 164 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 10 W S 35 BT.

The sec. cor. is located at the west side of a sandstone boulder, 5 x 5 x 5 ft. in place, on the right bank of Bob Creek. Chisel a large X in stone, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. E. of corner point.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy and rocky loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, alder, cedar, and maple.

Undergrowth, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, vine maple, hazel, salal and arrowwood.

S. 89°15' E., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Ascend 5 ft. along edge of bottom, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

A branch, 4 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 120 ft. along broken S. slope.
