

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the N. Bdy. of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS 17.40	A ravine, course S. 10° W.; asc. 170 ft. over SW. slope.
20.00	A spur, slopes S. 10° W.; desc. 106 ft. over SE. slope.
23.00	A branch, 4 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 300 ft. over SW. slope.
30.30	W. shoulder of spur, slopes SW.; thence along broken S. slope.
34.30	E. shoulder of spur, slopes S.; desc. 93 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.
37.18	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked  $\frac{1}{4} \frac{S \ 36}{S \ 1}$ 1952  from which  A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 75° E., 60 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 BT.  A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S. 83°45' E., 79 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 BT.
	Descend 105 ft. along S. slope, changing to SE. slope.
45.00	A ravine, course SE.; asc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.
46.00	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 130 ft. over SE. slope.
48.70	A branch, 7 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 160 ft. over NW. slope, changing to steep N. slope.
68.00	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 331 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
74.36	The cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., R. 10 W.  Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder and yew. Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, salal, hazel, slickleaf, arrowwood and poison oak.

	From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.  N. 3°50' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36, marking and blazing the true line.  Descend 210 ft. over N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
7.70	A branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 75° E.; asc. 394 ft. over SE. slope.
26.80	A ridge, bears N. 62½° E. and S. 62½° W.; desc. 73 ft. over NW. slope.
29.90	A spur, slopes N. 30° W.; desc. 155 ft. over NE. slope.
33.60	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; desc. 32 ft. over broken NW. slope.
