

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS	T 20 S R 10 W <u> S 23 S 24 </u> S 26 S 25 1951
	from which A yew, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 48° E., 5 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 24 BT. A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S. 13° E., 97 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 25 BT. An alder, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 57° W., 48 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 26 BT. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 57½° W., 34 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 23 BT. Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, yew and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, manzanita and thimbleberry.
	From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on the E. bdy. of the Tp. S. 87°07' W., bet. secs. 24 and 25. Ascend 223 ft. over broken SE. slope, changing to S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
14.50	A ravine, course SE.; asc. 260 ft. over E. slope.
19.45	A ridge, the divide bet. Bear Creek and Spencer Creek, bears N. and S.; desc. 316 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
29.30	A ravine, course N. 60° W.; asc. 40 ft. over NE. slope.
32.75	A spur, slopes N. 75° W.; desc. 230 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
37.50	An intermittent stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 80 ft. over NE. slope.
38.755	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked $\frac{1}{4} \frac{S 24}{S 25}$ 1951
	from which A fir, 64 ins. diam., bears N. 73° W., 64 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 24 BT. A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 55° E., 42½ lks. dist., marked ¼ S 25 BT. Ascend 80 ft. over NE. slope.
42.60	A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 193 ft. over W. slope.
46.00	The dry bed of a stream, 12 lks. wide, course N. 5° W.; asc. 150 ft. over E. slope.
49.05	A spur, slopes N.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.
