49.70	A ravine, course N. 10° W.; asc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.
51.10	A small spur, slopes N.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.
53.40	A ravine, course N. 15° E.; asc. 290 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
59.30	A spur ridge, bears N. and S. 5° W.; desc. 60 ft. along broken N. slope.
71.10	A spur, slopes N. 10° W.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
75.80	A spur ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 60° E.; desc. 35 ft. along S. slope.
77.51	The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple. Undergrowth, salmonberry, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, red huckleberry, arrowwood, thimbleberry and salal.
	N. 7°35' E., bet. secs. 23 and 24.
	Ascend 6 ft. over S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
0.40	A spur ridge, bears E. and S. 60° W.; desc. 280 ft. over NE. slope.
6.00	A ravine, course NW.; asc. 30 ft. along W. slope.
10.00	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 215 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
15.60	A creek, 20 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 625 ft. over broken S. slope, changing to SE. slope.
37.76	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

	Ascend 275 ft. over SE. slope.
47.00	A ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 120 ft. over N. slope.
50.00	The head of a ravine, course N. 50° W.; asc. 15 ft. along W. slope.
54.00	A spur ridge, bears N. 37° W. and S. 37° E.; desc. 280 ft. over NE. slope.
61.00	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; asc. 90 ft. over broken W. slope.
