	A cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 56½° W., 66 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 BT.
	Ascend 3 ft. along N. slope.
46.80	Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 95 ft. over NW. slope, changing to W. slope.
50.90	A ravine, course NW.; asc. 54 ft. over NE. slope.
52.20	Point of spur, slopes NE.; desc. 121 ft. over NW. slope.
58.50	A ravine, course N. 25° W.; ascend 26 ft. over NE. slope.
59.20	Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 47 ft. along N. slope.
65.05	Point of spur, slopes NW.; desc. 66 ft. over W. slope.
66.40	A branch, 3 lks. wide, in bare rock channel, 6 lks. wide, course N. 20° W.; asc. 157 ft. over NE. slope, changing to broken N. slope.

	Descend 91 ft. over bluffy NE. slope, covered with thimbleberry.

18.50	A ravine, course S. 40° W.; asc. 259 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope.
24.00	A spur ridge, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 270 ft. over N. slope.
29.15	A ravine, course N. 30° W.; asc. 14 ft. over SW. slope.
30.40	A small spur, slopes S. 35° W.; desc. 96 ft. over NW. slope.
