

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS	
	From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the E. bdy. of the Tp. S. 68°14' W., bet. secs. 12 and 13.
	Ascend 12 ft. along S. slope, changing to SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
0.65	A spur, slopes S. 5° E.; desc. 65 ft. over SW. slope.
2.30	A ravine, course S. 5° E.; asc. 175 ft. over SE. slope.
9.00	A ridge, the divide bet. Johnson Creek and Spencer Creek, bears NE. and S. 30° E.; desc. 270 ft. over NW. slope.
15.30	A ravine, at forks from S. 30° E. and N. 68° E., course NW.; desc. 1 ft. over broken NW. slope.
17.00	A ravine, course N. 15° W.; asc. 66 ft. over NE. slope.
18.40	The point of a spur, slopes N.; desc. 14 ft. over NW. slope.
20.00	A ravine, course N.; asc. 125 ft. over NE. slope.
22.10	A spur, slopes NE.; thence along N. slope.
23.60	A spur ridge, bears N. 75° W. and S. 75° E.; desc. 410 ft. over SW. slope.
36.80	The dry bed of a stream, 6 lks. wide, course N. 70° W. on bend to NW.; asc. 170 ft. over NE. slope.
41.60	A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.
42.90	A ravine, course N.; asc. 21 ft. over NE. slope.
43.555	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked.

49.60	A branch, 1 lk. wide, in bare rock channel, 5 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc. 200 ft. over E. slope.
53.40	A spur, slopes N.; desc. 30 ft. over NW. slope.
54.60	Foot of descent; asc. 20 ft. along N. slope.
57.75	A spur, slopes N. 40° W.; desc. 210 ft. over W. slope.
62.00	A ravine, course N. 40° W.; asc. 170 ft. over NE. slope.
66.70	A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 260 ft. over SW. slope.
72.80	A ravine, course N. 60° W.; desc. 50 ft. over broken NW. slope.
