| 53.40 | Cedar Creek, 3 lks. wide, in gravel channel, 10 lks. wide, course N. 65° W.; asc. 64 ft. over NE. slope. |
| 57.30 | Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 23 ft. over NW. slope. |
| 58.15 | A ravine, course N.; asc. 139 ft. over NE. slope. |
| 64.60 | A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 153 ft. over W. slope. |

| | Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, elder, rhododendron, and wild cucumber. |

| | Descend 72 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. |
| 3.75 | A spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 348 ft. over N. slope. |
| 10.80 | Cedar Creek, 3 lks. wide, in bare rock channel, 15 lks. wide, course NW., on bend to N. 60° W.; asc. 203 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 17.00 | Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 110 ft. over NW. slope. |
| 20.55 | A ravine, with bare rock bottom, course S. 70° W.; asc. 390 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope. |
| 28.45 | A spur, slopes S. 75° W.; desc. 325 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope. |
| 37.60 | An intermittent stream, 8 lks. wide, on bare rock bottom, course S. 75° W.; asc. 5 ft. over SW. slope. |
