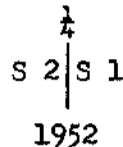


Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS



from which

A hemlock, 25 ins. diam., bears N. $42\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 52 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 BT.

A maple, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W., 26 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 BT.

Ascend 200 ft. over SW. slope.

- 42.05 A spur, slopes S. 65° W.; desc. 38 ft. over NW. slope.
- 44.05 A ravine, course S. 80° W.; asc. 112 ft. over SW. slope.
- 47.40 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 70 ft. over NW. slope.
- 51.00 A ravine, course S. 60° W.; asc. 295 ft. over broken S. slope.
- 57.50 A ridge, the divide bet. Cedar Creek and Bob Creek, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 660 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 77.80 A branch, 1 lk. wide, with bare rock bottom, 8 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 55 ft. over SE. slope.
- 79.60 A spur, slopes N. 75° E.; desc. 147 ft. over N. slope.
- 83.27 Bob Creek, 3 lks. wide, in bare rock channel, 12 lks. wide, course N. 80° W., on bend from SE.
- 83.52 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder and maple.
Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, salal, rhododendron and hazel.

From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. $1^\circ 47'$ E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Descend 300 ft. over E. slope, changing to NE. slope, through fern opening.

- 1.00 Edge of fern opening, bears E. and W.; enter scattering timber.
- 12.20 Dailey Creek, 15 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 100 ft. over SW. slope.
- 18.50 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 185 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
- 29.60 A tractor road, along edge of bottom meadow, bears N. 85° E. and S. 85° W.; thence across meadow.
- 30.75 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; desc. 15 ft. over gentle N. slope.
- 33.22 Point for the meander cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
