

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

$$\begin{array}{r} T\ 20\ S\ R\ 10\ W \\ \hline S\ 22\ | S\ 23 \\ \hline S\ 27\ | S\ 26 \\ \hline 1951 \end{array}$$

from which new bearing trees

A fir, 66 ins. diam., bears N. $15\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 36 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 23 BT.

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S. $32^\circ 45'$ W., 72 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 27 BT.

The sec. cor. is located at the top of a spur, which slopes East.

Land, mountainous and rolling.

Soil, sandy loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, chinquapin, yew and cascara.

Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, hazel, arrowwood, slickleaf, manzanita and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

N. $87^\circ 17'$ W., bet. secs. 23 and 26.

Descend 528 ft. along S. slope, changing to SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

17.40 An intermittent branch, 10 lks. wide, course NW.; desc. 70 ft. along steep broken N. slope.

39.045 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 26, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

$$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} S\ 23 \\ \hline S\ 26 \\ \hline 1951 \end{array}$$

from which

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears N. $44\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 100 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 23 BT.

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 16° E., 99 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 BT.

Descend 9 ft. over gradual NW. slope.

40.50 Spencer Creek, 48 lks. wide, course SW., on bend to W.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.

45.60 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.

54.50 Spencer Creek, 40 lks. wide; course N. 30° W.; asc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.

57.00 Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.

58.00 A blazed trail, bears N. and S.

62.50 Spencer Creek, 40 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 150 ft. over SE. slope.

67.40 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 95 ft. over SW. slope.
