

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, alder and maple.
Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, rhododendron and arrowwood.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

N. 88°57' W., bet. secs. 2 and 11.

Descend 83 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 1.55 A ravine, course N. 15° W.; desc. 25 ft. along N. slope.
- 2.85 A wet ravine, course N. 10° W.; asc. 121 ft. over NE. slope.
- 5.65 A spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. 70 ft. along broken N. slope.
- 7.90 A spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 150 ft. over NW. slope.
- 11.15 A ravine, course N.; asc. 360 ft. over NE. slope.
- 19.10 A spur, slopes N. 10° E.; desc. 1 foot along N. slope.
- 20.70 A spur ridge, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; desc. 580 ft. over broken SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
- 38.59 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 11, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
$$\frac{1}{4} \frac{S 2.}{S 11}$$

An alder, 19 ins. diam., bears N. 84 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 49 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 BT.
A cedar, 60 ins. diam., bears S. 86° W., 81 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 11 BT.
Descend 2 ft. over W. slope.
- 38.85 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; ascend 80 ft. over NE. slope.
- 41.20 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 17 ft. over NW. slope.
- 42.15 A ravine, course N. 30° E.; asc. 310 ft. over steep broken NE. slope.
- 49.45 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 301 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 57.40 A ravine, course N. 35° W.; asc. 12 ft. over NE. slope.
- 59.50 A spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope.
- 61.80 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 25° E., in bare rock channel, 10 lks. wide; asc. 106 ft. over E. slope.
- 64.00 Point of spur, slopes SE.; desc. 6 ft. over SW. slope.
- 64.70 A ravine, course SE.; asc. 290 ft. over NE. slope.
- 70.30 A spur, slopes SE.; desc. 102 ft. over SW. slope.
- 75.00 A ravine, course S.; asc. 93 ft. over SE. slope.
