

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

from which

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S. $51\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 46 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 BT.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 51 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 BT.

Descend 180 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope.

41.30 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course East; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.

41.80 Point of spur, slopes S. 60° E.; desc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.

42.30 The dry bed of a stream, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 725 ft. over broken SW. slope, changing to SE. slope.

62.50 A ridge, the divide bet. Smith River and North Fork of Smith River, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 200 ft. over broken N. slope.

69.50 A ravine, course NW.; desc. 135 ft. along broken W. slope, changing to NW. slope.

73.80 A ravine, course N. 70° W.; asc. 70 ft. over SW. slope.

75.44 The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, determined at the record bearing and distance from each of the remaining original bearing trees, as follows:

A fir stump, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 76° E., 9 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on sliver of old blaze.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. $76\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 23 lks. dist., with blaze opened and the marks burned.

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N. 46° W., 12 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on partly opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. $81^{\circ}15'$ E., 45 lks. dist., marked T 20 S-R 10 W-S 22 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $69\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 26 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 27 BT.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. $64^{\circ}45'$ W., 40 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 28 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, cascara and chinquapin.

Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, arrowwood, rhododendron, slickleaf, salmonberry, thimbleberry, manzanita, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 22, 23m 26 and 27.
