Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, yew and cascara.
Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, thimbleberry, hazel, red huckleberry, evergreen huckleberry, elder, wild cucumber, salal, arrowwood and manzanita.

N. 0°24' E., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Ascend 95 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 1.90 A spur, slopes N. 70° W.; desc. 145 ft. over N. slope.
- 5.20 A ravine, course NW.; thence along W. slope.
- 6.10 Point of a spur, slopes N. 70° W.; desc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
- 7.20 The dry bed of a stream, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° W.; asc. 300 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope.
- 14.20 A spur ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 350 ft. over broken NE. slope, changing to N. slope.
- 23.10 The dry bed of a stream, 5 lks. wide, course N. 70° W.; asc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.
- 25.20 Point of spur, slopes S. 85° W.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
- 27.30 The dry bed of a stream, 3 lks. wide, course S. 65° W.; asc. 390 ft. over S. slope.
- 35.90 A spur ridge, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 55 ft. over N. slope.
- 37.17 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

 - A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 5° E., 38 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 22 BT.
 - A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 17° W., 52 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 BT.

Descend 200 ft. over N. slope.
- 40.60 The dry bed of a stream, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; desc. 6 ft. along W. slope.
- 41.25 The dry bed of a stream, 3 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 280 ft. over SW. slope.
- 49.80 A ridge, the divide bet. North Fork of Smith River and Smith River, bears NW. and S. 35° E.; desc. 90 ft. over NE. slope.
- 55.10 The head of a ravine, course E.; asc. 105 ft. over SE. slope.
- 62.00 Recross divide, bears N. 75° E. and S. 60° W.; desc. 150 ft. over N. slope, changing to broken NW. slope.
