	A hemlock, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 70 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 16 BT.				
	An alder, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 33° W., 36 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W S 9 BT.				
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder and maple. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, rhododendron, arrowwood and salal.
