CHAINS 16.50	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 137 ft. over NE. slope.
22.60	A spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 94 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
26.65	A spur, slopes N. 50° W.; desc. 233 ft. over W. slope.
31.22	A ravine, course N. 30° W.; asc. 15 ft. over NE. slope.
32.10	A spur, slopes N.; desc. 107 ft. over W. slope.
34.75	A creek, 1 lk. wide, in gravel bed 15 lks. wide, course S., approx. 2 chs. below bend from NE.; asc. 71 ft. over E. slope.
36.80	Point of a spur, slopes S. 30° E.; desc. 18 ft. over SW. slope.
38.40	A branch, 1 lk. wide, in gravel bed 5 lks. wide, course S. 50° E.; ascend 26 ft. over NE. slope.
38.915	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

	A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 73 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 181 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 BT.
	Ascend 407 ft. over NE. slope, changing to SE. slope.
51.80	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 208 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
58.40	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 25° W.; asc. 122 ft. over SE. slope.
63.00	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 182 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
69.45	A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 139 ft. over SE. slope.
76.35	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 17 ft. over gradual SW. slope.
77.83	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder and maple. Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, salal, salmon-berry, thimbleberry, rhododendron and arrowwood.
	N. 0°51' W., bet. secs. 4 and 5.
	Ascend 81 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
4.10	A spur, slopes S. 70° W.; desc. 330 ft. over NW. slope.
18.20	The dry bed of a stream, 2 lks. wide, course N. 70° W.; asc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.
19.40	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
