21.20	A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.
24.00	Top of ascent on W. slope; thence along W. slope.
31.00	Commence descent; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
32.90	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° W.; asc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
33.43	The local $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, monumented by a private surveyor and accepted by the interested property owners, monumented with an iron pipe, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. above ground, firmly set, with iron pipe cap marked

	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
