CHAINS 3.90	Leave level and enter rolling land, bears E. and W. Enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.
4.41	To Cor. No. 6, identical with Cor. H/8 of listing survey, a fir tree, 24 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor; I blaze and scribe the tree 6 H E S 141 on SE. face for Cor. 6; from which  A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 87°45' E., 59 lks. dist.,  A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 65°00' W., 61 lks. dist., both trees blazed and scribed 6 H E S 141 BT.  Land, rolling and level. Timber, pine, fir and cedar. Soil, 1st rate.
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	Thence -  S. 83°03' E., on true line to Cor. 7.  Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
9.00	Claimant's fence, bears S. 83°03' E., along line.
11.15	Leave fence, bears NE.
12.63	To Cor. No. 7, identical with Cor. H/7 of listing survey, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor; in place of which I  Set an igneous stone, 24 x 12 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 7, mkd. 7 H E S 141 on SE. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which  A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 44°45' E., 84 lks. dist.,  A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 78°30' W., 6½ lks. dist., both trees blazed and scribed 7 H E S 141 BT.  Land, rolling. Timber, pine, fir and cedar. Soil, 2nd rate.
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	Thence -  N. 51°58' E., on true line to Cor. 8.  Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
2.45	Claimant's fence, bears easterly and westerly. Leave timber and undergrowth, bears NW. and SE. Enter clearing and follow along edge of timber.
6.28	Claimant's fence, bears NW. and SE.
7.46	Same fence, bears NE. and SW.
10.50	Enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.
17.50	Leave rolling and enter level land, bears NW. and SE.
