Land, level and rolling.
 Timber, pine, fir and cedar.
 Soil, 1st rate.

Thence -

S. 44°13' E., on true line to Cor. 11.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

6.00 Leave rolling and enter level land, bears NW. and SE.

6.97 Deadman Creek, course SE., along line.

8.40 Leave creek, course SE.

9.24 To Cor. No. 11, identical with Cor. H/4 of listing survey, an ash tree, 18 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor.

I blaze and scribe the tree 11 H E S 141 on SW. face, for Cor. 11; from which

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 9°15' E., 48 lks. dist.,

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 67°45' E., 31 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 11 H E S 141 BT.

Land, rolling and level.
 Timber, pine, fir, cedar, maple and ash.
 Soil, 1st rate.

Thence -

S. 58°28' E., on true line to Cor. 12.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

4.84 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.

7.00 Leave level and enter rolling land, bears NW. and SE.

21.18 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course southerly.

21.81 To Cor. No. 12, identical with Cor. H/3 of listing survey, a maple tree, 24 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor.

I blaze and scribe the tree, 12 H E S 141 on W. face, for Cor. 12; from which

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 3°30' E., 26 lks. dist.,

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 37°30' W., 34 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 12 H E S 141 BT.

Land, level and rolling.
 Timber, pine, fir, cedar, maple and ash.
 Soil, 2nd rate.

Thence -

S. 13°24' W., on true line to Cor. 13.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
