 both trees blazed and scribed 15 H E S 141 BT.

15.00 Leave cultivated land, bears NW. and SE. Enter heavy timber and dense undergrowth, bears NW. and SE.

20.33 To Cor. No. 16, identical with Cor. H/6 of listing survey, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I

Set a wash boulder, 24 x 10 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 16, chiseled 16 H E S 141 on S. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 55°00' E., 77 lks. dist.,

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 71°00' E., 69 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 16 H E S 141 BT.

Land, rolling and level.
 Timber, pine, fir and cedar.
 Soil, 1st rate.

Cor. 8, Tract A, on West side of road exemption, bears S. 51°58' W., 63½ lks. dist.

Thence -

S. 6°21' E., on true line to Cor. 14.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

3.50 Leave level and enter rolling land, bears N. and S.

21.42 To Cor. No. 14, the place of beginning, heretofore described.
