The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, perpetuated with an iron pipe, 3 ins. diam., 14 ins. below ground.

from which a bearing tree marked by the County Surveyor in 1916:

A black oak, 44 ins. diam., bears S.  $30\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  W., 650 lks. dist., with marks 29 S R uncovered.

and bearing trees marked by the County Surveyor in 1954:

An apple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $56^\circ$  W., 262 lks. dist., marked S 8 CS.

A maple, 20 ins. diam., bears N.  $76^\circ$  W., 343 lks. dist., marked S 5 CS.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 35 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

Timber, fir, oak, maple and madrona.

Undergrowth, vine maple, arrowwood, poison oak and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

N.  $89^\circ 28'$  W., bet. secs. 4 and 9.

Descend 55 ft. over NW. slope, through timber and undergrowth.

1.69 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 157 ft. over NE. slope.

6.63 Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 208 ft. over NW. slope.

16.06 Intersect E. bdy. of donation land claim No. 41, at proportionate distance.
