

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 32 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS

N. 0°14' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Descend 187 ft. over NE. slope, through timber and undergrowth.

5.28 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 60° E.; asc. 115 ft. over SE. slope.

12.61 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 107 ft. over NE. slope.

17.92 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° E.; asc. 270 ft. over SE. slope.

39.43 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree:

A cedar, 28 ins. diam., bears West, 36 lks. dist., with marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S uncovered.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A cedar, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 38° E., 48 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 BT.

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 37° W., 66 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 BT.

N. 3°32' E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 238 ft. over SE. slope.

7.58 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 51 ft. over NE. slope.

10.07 Head of ravine, drains E.; asc. 116 ft. over SE. slope.

18.25 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 77 ft. over NE. slope.

22.99 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.; asc. 99 ft. over SE. slope.

29.07 Ridge, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.; desc. 173 ft. over NW. slope.

39.79 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 31 S., R. 5 W., of this group.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, maple, cedar and madrona; undergrowth, vine maple, huckleberry, arrowwood and hazel.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

N. 89°53' W., bet. secs. 3 and 10.

Ascend 44 ft. over NE. slope, through timber and undergrowth.

1.77 Spur, slopes NE.; asc. 91 ft. along N. slope.

11.15 Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 28 ft. over NW. slope.

13.00 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 60° E.; asc. 1031 ft. over E. slope.
