5.00	Enter nickel and chrome iron bed. Timber, heavy growth of small pine.
22.50	Var. 20°35' E.
25.00	Var. 19°45' E. Timber, pine. Ascend gradual slope of hill.
40.00	Intersect $\frac{1}{4}$ S. post between secs. 17 and 20. Marked post No. 2 Claim (37).
	Set post by established witness trees, to wit:
	A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 71 lks. dist.
	A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 5° E., 14 lks. dist.

	East, on N. Bdy. of Claim.
	Descend gradual slope of hill.
30.00	Leave nickel and chrome bed; enter serpentine formation.
40.00	Intersect at $\frac{1}{4}$ S. post between secs. 16 and 17. Marked post No 4 and claim 37.

	A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 8°30' W., 105 lks. dist.
	Timber, pine, fir and cedar. Altitude 1920 ft.
	South, on E. Bdy. of Claim.
	Descend gradual slope of hill.
25.00	House, bears S. 48° W., about 7.00 chs.
32.00	Small creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.
