DISCOVERY LODE

Beginning at Cor. No. 1, identical with the NE. cor. of location;  
from which

$\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. between secs. 27 and 28, T. 32 S., R. 7 W.,  
Willamette Meridian, Oregon, bears N. 7° E., 1550 ft.

A laurel post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground,  
with stone mound alongside, scribed C 1 & 1 M.S. 383; whence

A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 68½° W., 34 ft.

A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 8½° W., 50 ft.  
each blazed and scribed C 1 & 1 M.S. 383 BT.

Thence N. 75°00' W.

Var. 19° E.

300.00 Center post on northerly end of discovery lode.

A laurel post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground,  
with stone mound alongside, scribed M.S. 383; whence

Discovery shaft bears N. 79° E., 20 ft.

A high point on Hungry Hill, bears S. 9° W., about 3 miles  
distant.

353.00 An old ditch, No. 1, belonging to others.

425.00 An old ditch, No. 2, belonging to others.

514.00 Creek, 2 ft. wide, course S.

598.00 Old ditch No. 2.

600.00 To Cor. No. 2, identical with location corner.

A laurel post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground,  
with stone mound alongside, scribed C 2 & 4 M.S. 383; whence

A laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 29° E., 16 ft.  
blazed and scribed C 2 M.S. 383 BT.

A live oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 54° E., 34 ft.  
blazed and scribed C 4 M.S. 383 BT.

Thence S. 12°30' W.

Var. 19°10' E.

Descend gradually.

535.00 Wagon road.

1297.00 Intersect line bet. secs. 28 and 33, T. 32 S., R. 7 W., 1050 ft.  
West of corner.

1500.00 To Cor. No. 3, identical with location corner.

A laurel post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground,  
with stone mound alongside, scribed C 3 M.S. 383; whence

A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 29°30' E., 42 ft.,  
blazed and scribed C 3 M.S. 383 BT.

Thence S. 75°00' E.

Var. 19°10' E.

Descend steep hill.

208.00 Creek, 2 ft. wide, course S. Ascend steep hill.

300.00 Center post on southerly end of discovery lode.
