CHAINS

A laurel post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground, with stone mound alongside, scribed C 2 & 1 M.S. 383; whence

An alder, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 81° W., 51 ft., blazed and scribed C 2 M.S. 383 BT.

A laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 26° E., 15 ft., blazed and scribed C 1 M.S. 383 BT.

Thence N. $75^{\circ}00'$ W.

Var. 19° E.

Ascend steep hill.

300.00 To center on northerly end of Buck lode, identical with location corner.

A laurel post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground, with stone mound alongside, scribed M.S. 383.

600.00 To Cor. No. 3, identical with location corner.

A laurel post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground, with stone mound alongside, scribed C 3 & 4 M.S. 383; whence

A laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 62° E., 7 ft., blazed and scribed C 3 M.S. 383 BT.

A laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 82° E., 17 ft., blazed and scribed C 4 M.S. 383 BT.

Thence S. $26^{\circ}30'$ W.

Var. 19° E.

Descend steep hill.

1092.00 Intersect line bet. secs. 27 and 28, 370 ft. N. $0^{\circ}30'$ E. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

1500.00 To Cor. No. 4, identical with location corner and with Cor. No. 3 of the Gold Standard lode of this survey.

Thence S. $75^{\circ}00'$ E.

Var. 19° E.

Descend steep hill.

191.40 Intersect sec. line; $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 27 and 28 bears N. $0^{\circ}30'$ E., 53 ft. dist.

300.00 To center post on southerly end of Buck lode and identical with northerly end of Gold Standard lode of this survey.

600.00 To Cor. No. 1 and place of beginning.

HOOSIER LODE

Beginning at Cor. No. 1, identical with location corner and Cor. No. 2 of Buck lode of this survey; whence

$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 27 and 28, T. 32 S., R. 7 W. bears S. $42^{\circ}15'$ W., 1601 ft.

Thence N. $32^{\circ}30'$ E.

Var. 19° E.

Ascend steep hill.

1500.00 To Cor. No. 2, identical with location corner.

A laurel post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., set 18 ins. in the ground, with stone mound alongside, scribed C 2 & 1 M.S. 383; whence
