- No. 1 The discovery shaft of the Tom Boy lode, on the lode line, 10 ft. from a point on line 2-3, S. $82^{\circ}42'$ W., 300 ft. from Cor. No. 2; 4 x 6 ft., 10 ft. deep.

- No. 2 A tunnel the mouth of which bears, from the center of line 2-3, Tom Boy lode, S. $51^{\circ}03'$ W., 67.5 ft.; 5 x 7 ft., running N. $34^{\circ}50'$ E., 51.3 ft.; thence North, 37 ft.; thence N. $49^{\circ}19'$ W., 85.9 ft.; thence N. $19^{\circ}18'$ W., 17.4 ft.; thence N. $34^{\circ}31'$ E., 57.3 ft.; thence N. $74^{\circ}14'$ E., 101.5 ft. to face.
